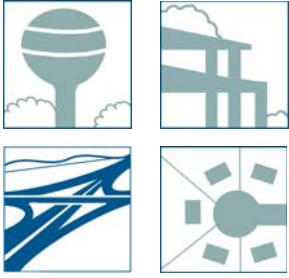


ROOSEVELT AVENUE AND HIGHWAY 122 TRAFFIC STUDY



Yaggy Colby Associates was selected by Mason City to conduct a traffic study to define congestion and safety issues along the Highway 122 corridor. The one-mile study area extended from Taft Avenue west to Eisenhower Avenue, with special emphasis given to the Highway 122 and Roosevelt Avenue intersection.
